First Meeting of Grimsby Ancient Mariners

At the first meeting of the Grimsby Ancient Mariners Monday 9th February 2015 the following decisions were made :

- a) The Grimsby Ancient Mariners Walking Football Club would come into existence on 1st March.
- b) The proposed constitution was adopted and will be made available on request and displayed on the Club Noticeboard at Bradley Centre.
- c) The named people named (Article Above) would serve as officers on the Committee of the Grimsby Ancient Mariners for a period of one year.
- d) Members would pay a subscription of 50p to Club Funds before each Walking Football session and this money would be paid into Club Funds from the 1st March 2015.
- e) The meeting elected Tony Parrott as Honorary President of the Grimsby Ancient Mariners in recognition of the major part he played in establishing our Walking Football Group.
- f) It was agreed that representatives of the Bradley Pitches be given a non-voting seat on Committee to ensure we maintain the excellent relationship we have built with them in the last two years.
- g) At the next meeting it was suggested that the aims of the Grimsby Ancient Mariners be discussed and set out to establish the principles of the Club
